Our fellows have access to an extensive network of former NYC alums

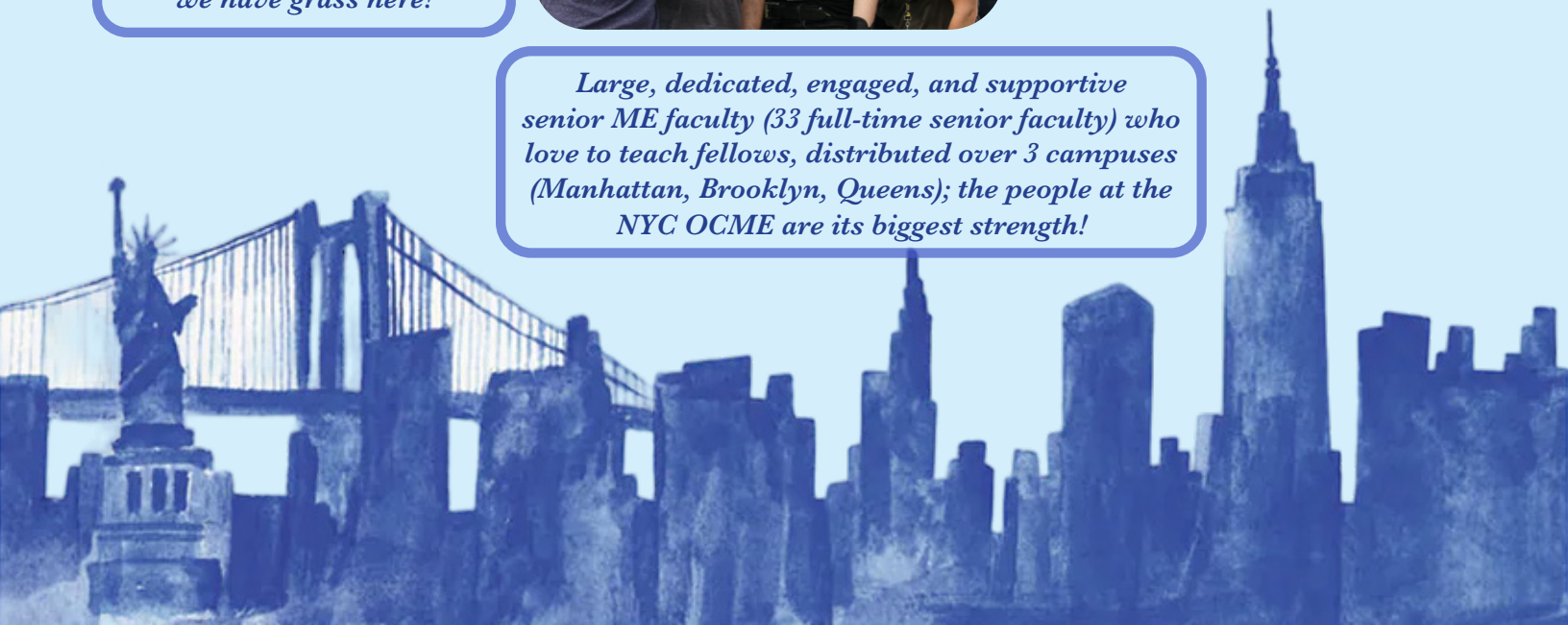
Opportunity for second fellowship training year in Forensic Neuropathology and Cardiovascular Pathology, with on staff neuropathology and cardiovascular pathology attendings

Rotations: Forensic Toxicology, Anthropology, Biology/DNA; Investigations and NYPD ride alongs; 2-day Human Remains Recovery Course with the Anthro team and NYPD (with a helicopter ride and cadaver dogs!!) Turns out - we have grass here!



8.8 million resident population plus daily commuter and tourism traffic; 5 counties (NY, Bronx, Kings, Queens, Richmond); deaths reported: >40k; OCME jurisdiction: >10k, with a wide breadth of cases

NYC OCME FELLOWSHIP AT A GLANCE



- *In-house full-time Forensic Anthropology Department with 3 (2 board-certified) PhD Forensic Anthropologists and one Master's level Anthropologist, Forensic Anthropology lab ISO accreditation*
- *Molecular Genetics Diagnostic laboratory (Cardiogenetics, SUDEP, Thrombophilias, etc.) with a board-certified medical geneticist MD/PhD Laboratory Director and a board-certified, full-time Clinical Genetic Counselor*
- *Specialized Drug Intelligence and Intervention Group (DIIG) with partnerships with federal, state, and local public health and public safety stakeholders*
- *In-house accredited Forensic Toxicology laboratory, with interactive, collegial consultations with staff Forensic Toxicologists*
- *Academic appointments for ME staff (including fellows), Department of Forensic Medicine, New York University Grossman School of Medicine*
- *Several opportunities to testify in grand juries and trials during fellowship year; specialized Expert Testimony lecture series*
- *Adult and pediatric clinical radiology consultants on standby, as needed; full CT scanning capabilities in all forensic pathology centers expected within the next year*
- *In-house Continuing Medical Education (CME/ MOC) programs, including weekly Grand Rounds; opportunities to attend national & regional conferences*
- *World-renown subject matter expertise in mass fatality incident management and disaster preparedness with training and participation opportunities for ME staff; full-time Special Operations Division staff*
