

The Maryland Office of the Chief Medical Examiner is seeking Per Diem Forensic Pathologists to assist our team of skilled medical examiners in conducting autopsies on weekdays or weekends beginning as soon as reasonably possible.

Our free-standing, modern 120,000 square foot facility is located in Baltimore, Maryland on the campus of the University of Maryland, Baltimore (UMB). Work in a well-equipped office with:

- CT scanner and LODOX machine
- Transcription service and VPN available
- In-house toxicology lab with turnaround times typically under one week
- In-house histology lab
- Support staff of 15 autopsy technicians and photographers; 14 medical examiners, 4 Fellows
- Consulting services include anthropology, odontology, cardiovascular pathology, radiology and neuropathology

Requirements:

The ideal candidate is a board-certified Forensic Pathologist. Must have experience working in a Medical Examiner's Office. A Maryland medical license is required upon start.

- Case types: Drugs, MVAs, non-complicated suicides, etc. and avoiding the homicides and babies unless approved by the Chief Medical Examiner
- At least 3 cases per day, number of cases flexible, depending on caseload
- Schedule flexibility to include weekends and weekdays
- State of Maryland provides liability insurance for work performed by Per Diem Forensic Pathologists
- Travel and accommodations not covered
- Payment once the case is complete and closed
