



## **Travis County (Austin, TX) Medical Examiner/ University of Texas Medical Branch Hospitals Program**

### **Forensic Pathology Fellowship Opening for 2021-2022**

**Description:** The Travis County Medical Examiner's Office (TCME), with sponsorship from the University of Texas Medical Branch Hospitals Program, offers an ACGME-accredited, one-year fellowship in forensic pathology. We are currently able to take two fellows per year and we have one slot remaining for 2021-2022. TCME is located in Austin, Texas – a city with much to offer! Our office has a staff of eight board-certified forensic pathologists. We investigate deaths in Travis County (which has a population of approximately 1.1 million) and we also take referral cases from 43 other counties in central Texas. In 2019, our office performed 1993 autopsies and 345 external examinations. The office is accredited by the National Association of Medical Examiners and our in-house toxicology laboratory is accredited by the American Board of Forensic Toxicology. In January of 2018, we moved into our new, state-of-the art facility with a computed tomography scanner, which offers a unique educational opportunity for fellows.
