

Maricopa County is the fourth largest and fastest growing county in the nation! Learn from our dedicated team of Medical Examiners. Our NAME (National Association of Medical Examiners)-accredited, state-of-the-art Medical Examiner's Office is located in Phoenix, Arizona.

The office has two (2) fellowship positions available annually and participates in the NRMP Match. The fellowship positions are considered County employees and are afforded an excellent benefits package that includes enrollment in the Arizona State Retirement System, comprehensive county benefits, vacation and sick leave, and a free public transit pass.

Our fellows will develop forensic autopsy and investigative skills and "forensic thinking" through exposure to a wide range of trauma and disease medical death investigation cases. Additionally, the fellows will experience dedicated rotations in toxicology, forensic science/crime lab, anthropology, odontology, and scene investigation. Our primary goal is to provide exceptional education to our fellows. By the end of the year, fellows will have the knowledge, skill, and experience to investigate and certify any type of death.



## Why You Should Train With Us

- Train with a cohesive team of board-certified forensic pathologists (19 in total), two physician assistants, a forensic anthropologist, and a forensic odontologist. Locum tenens physicians cover shifts when there are vacancies for effective, year-round staffing.

   Option to telecommute when not in exams. Administrative, public health, crime lab, and court partner facilities are within walking distance of the office.

- Complete support staff 36 ABMDI-certified investigators who
  respond to the majority of jurisdictional scenes and staff the
  office 24 hours a day, seven days a week; 19 forensic

  clerks; and a full administrative support staff.
- Histology services are provided in-house with a 5-7 day average turnaround-time. Toxicology testing is provided by an external laboratory with an average two-week turnaround-time.
